


How To Reach The Venue?

(Dhahran Expo)





By Car

Dhahran Expo located in the center of the Eastern Province of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, between the cities Khobar, Dammam, and Dhahran. Easily accessible by car from different road links through the coastal road, just 10 minutes from the city centers, and 3.5 hours from Riyadh or 4 hours through railway. And, 3.5 hours from Kuwait.

Air Travel

King Fahd International Airport (KFIA) is currently the third largest international airport in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in terms of passenger volume. It is considered as the largest land area in the world, with a total of 780 square kilometers. King Fahd International Airport is just 35 kilometers away from Dhahran Expo.





Through King Fahd Causeway

30 minutes by car from Bahrain to Dhahran Expo through King Fahd Causeway, the 25km-long causeway links the Kingdom of Bahrain with the Eastern Province.

By Train

The train station is 10 minutes away from the Dhahran Expo, the railways connect the cities of the Kingdom together. The time duration to get from Riyadh to Dammam is only 4 hours.


To Find Dhahran Expo Location on Goggle Maps






SIPHA23 | THE ANNUAL MEETING OF SPS

Weather

January, the same as December, in Dammam, Saudi Arabia, is an agreeable winter month, with an average temperature varying between 21.1°C (70°F) and 9.5°C (49.1°F).



Temperature

With an average high-temperature of 21.1°C (70°F) and an average low-temperature of 9.5°C (49.1°F), January is the coldest month.




Humidity


The months with the highest humidity are January and December, with an average relative humidity of 59%.



Rainfall

In Dammam, Saudi Arabia, during January, the rain falls for 9.3 days and regularly aggregates up to 20mm (0.79") of precipitation. In Dammam, during the entire year, the rain falls for 38.8 days and collects up to 86mm (3.39") of precipitation.






USEFUL INFORMATION

Language




The official language is Arabic; however, English is also widely spoken.
